## **Pupil Premium Provision Review 2018-19**

Pupil premium is additional funding given to all schools to support pupils who are deemed to be disadvantaged. The Government provide this funding and use the entitlement of free school meals as the measure. The current funding for this school year is £58,600.00, allocated in the following ways:

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

PSA qualified as THRIVE Practitioner Initial roll out of THRIVE Approach (1:1 work with specific individuals)




